LAWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

COVID-19

Dec 15: The GNWT released a [new report](#) analyzing the long-term social and psychological impact of public health measures put in place during the pandemic to minimize risks of COVID-19 infection, including with regard to mental health and addictions, alcohol-related harm and family violence.

New Laws

Dec 16: Applications began for financial support of projects to reduce poverty under the 2023 Anti-Poverty Fund. The deadline for project sponsors [to apply](#) is January 31, 2023.

Workers Comp

Nov 17: The WSCC released its [2023-2027 Strategic Plan](#) outlining what it wants to accomplish over the next 5 years. One of the key objectives is to reduce lost-time injury claims rates (which was 1.8 in 2021) to 1.68 per 100 workers by 2027.
