New Laws

Jun 30: Even as wildfires continue to rage, Yukon launched a new recovery program to support residents, farmers and business owners who suffered uninsured losses as a result of the recent floods in the Klondike Valley, including up to \$250,000 for housing, \$500,000 for agricultural damage and \$500,000 for damages to small businesses.

New Laws

Jul 26: Yukon and Nova Scotia signed a 2-year letter of intent promising to work together to address recruitment, hiring, retention and other HR initiatives in the vital healthcare sector where skilled labour is in short supply.
