LAWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

Labour Standards

Jul 24: The Nunavut Literary Council, aka Iliitaqsiniq, is halfway through a pilot project testing the idea of shifting all staff to a 4-day workweek, Monday through Thursday, while keeping salaries and benefits the same in the interests of improving employee mental health, morale and work-life balance.

New Laws

Jul 6: The federal government and GN announced that they've reached agreement in principle on a new plan to invest \$381 million in federal funding over the next 10 years to support projects to improve healthcare infrastructure and services in Nunavut.

Health & Safety

Jul 5: WSCC issued [new guidance](#) to help employers and workers prevent hand injuries. More than 20% of all workers comps filed in 2022 involved injuries to the fingers, arms and upper extremities, according to the agency.
