New Laws

Jul 29: The federal government announced that it will invest over \$19 million to fund 3 different Indigenous-led clean energy projects in Naujaat, Rankin Inlet and Baker Lake to reduce diesel fuel consumption, promote development and create jobs in Nunavut.

New Laws

Jul 4: The Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) initiated measures to bring high-speed fibre Internet to 4 remote Inuit communities in Nunavut. The \$271.9 million investment will go to building a 1,300-kilometre fibre link to connect Iqaluit, Kinngait, Coral Harbour and Kimmirut to high-speed Internet services.

Workers Comp

Jul 11: The WSCC will establish separate Yearly Maximum Insurable Remuneration (YMIR) values for the Northwest Territories and Nunavut, effective January 1, 2025. The YMIR is the maximum earnings for calculating compensation benefits and the payroll reporting limit for employers.
