



LAWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

New Laws

Jul 28: Yukon, Northwest Territories and Nunavut signed a Memorandum of Understanding to create a new Territorial Trade Zone, a kind of Northern Common Market through which goods, services and labour will flow freely. Among other things, the territories will create a shared credential registry allowing qualified professionals to ply their trade in all 3 territories.

New Laws

Jul 23: In addition to the new Territorial Trade Zone initiative, Yukon announced that it has signed a pair of bilateral interprovincial free trade and labour mobility agreements, one with Alberta and the other with BC.

New Laws

Jul 17: Yukon released further details about its new Trade Resilience Program to support businesses affected by U.S. tariffs and Canadian countermeasures. Funding will be provided via 3 streams: Stream 1 for industry organizations, Stream 2 for individual businesses and Stream 3 for projects commissioned by the Yukon government.

New Laws

Jul 3: The Governments of Canada and Yukon announced that they will provide more than \$17 million in joint funding to prevent and combat wildfires in Whitehorse, Teslin and Haines Junction—communities in the northern boreal forest region that are prone to aggressive wildfire behaviour.
