New Laws

Nov 3: The Yukon Party ended nearly a decade of Liberal rule and secured a majority government by capturing 51% of the vote and 14 of the territory's 21 seats, the largest caucus for any party in Yukon history. Party leader Currie Dixon will become Yukon's 12th premier.

Workplace Violence

Nov 24: New Yukon Bureau of Statistics numbers show that the territory continues to have some of the highest per-capita rates of police-reported family and intimate partner violence in all of Canada. Between 2023 and 2024, the number of reported incidents of family violence in Yukon increased by 1.2% while reported incidents of intimate partner increased 6.7%.

Health & Safety

Nov 10: Yukon Public Libraries began lending out radon screeners. Each kit comes with a digital screening device, radon information and instructions on screener use and what to do if high radon levels are detected. There are 15 screeners available: 10 at Whitehorse Public Library and 1 each in Carcross, Carmacks, Dawson, Haines Junction, and Watson Lake libraries.
