### **Wages & Salary**

Apr 1: To bolster recruitment and retention of staff in licensed child-care centres, the Nunavut Department of Education's Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) division increased the ELCC Wage Scale Program rates by 3%. The ECLC wage scale covers four categories of staff: Management, Early childhood educators, Program support, and Centre support.

### **Training**

March 31 is the deadline [to apply](#) for Nunavut Mine Training Fund (NMTF) support for community-based training initiatives in the mining industry and related fields. Examples of eligible training programs include pre-employment, introduction to mining, environmental monitoring, and operation of heavy equipment.

### **Health & Safety**

Feb 18: Nunavut's Department of Health reminded residents about the importance of keeping up to date with immunizations. It's especially important that children receive routine immunizations on time to protect them from serious vaccine-preventable diseases such as measles, pertussis, and RSV.
